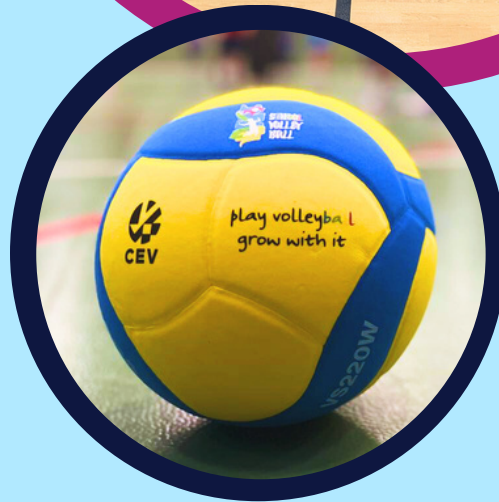

Ambassador Course

The Ambassadors Course has been carefully designed to provide an introduction to leading a volleyball session in a community and educational environment.

The course is primarily delivered by our Foundation Officer over three hours or two double periods, and will give pupils and volunteers the confidence to assist with junior school provision or primary school pupils the basics of volleyball. It is very popular for schools or local authorities who run leadership academies or offer a SCQF Sports Coaching course. It is recommended that candidates should be at least 16 years of age to do the course, but there is flexibility around this and can be discussed at the time of booking.

The cost of the course is £15 per pupil for affiliated schools, which includes membership for the 2026/27 year. Each participant will receive a certificate of completion and a bank of coaching resources.





Young Official Course

Our Young Official Course is a new addition to our offering! This course is ran over 2 hours or double period and teaches school pupils how referee a game of volleyball.

This course is a great starting point for pupils who want to get involved in volleyball and presents opportunities to ref School Cup games, interschool league matches, and festival games which can help lead them into becoming a Grade 4 referee.

The cost of the course is £10 per pupil for affiliated schools, which includes membership for the 2026/27 year. Each participant will receive a whistle, referee cards, certificate of completion and a digital Young Officials manual.

Entry Requirements

- All schools must be affiliated with SV before participating.
- Each participant must have a Tier 3 membership.



Rules for Play

- Games are played on a badminton court.
- Teams must also referee.
- Please refer to the Festival Rule Book for all rules.



General Format

- All matches are timed.
- The morning session is round-robin styled play.
- The afternoon session is pool-play based on morning results.



Team Composition

S3/4

- Teams should consist of 4 players on the court at all times
- Up to 2 subs
- Mixed gender

S5/6

- Teams should consist of 6 players on the court at all times
- Up to 2 subs
- Same gender (all boy/girl)

School Cup

Why Play?

The School Cup is one of Scottish Volleyball's longest running competitions with its Final taking place as part of our showcase event, National Cup Finals Weekend.

This competition is a great opportunity to compete against different schools all across Scotland. The initial rounds are regionalised and schools losing in the initial rounds get the opportunity to compete in the School Plate.



Registration

Schools should email **competitions@scottishvolleyball.org** to enter.

There is a £25 entry fee per team.

Each school must be affiliated and each player have a Tier 3 Membership.

Teacher CPD



The Scottish Volleyball team can provide Continuous Professional Development (CPD) sessions for Physical Education (PE) teachers nationwide. The development team are frequent presenters at the SATPE Conference and their sessions are consistently well-received.

CPD sessions can be delivered on in-service days or after school! Delivery is subject to minimum numbers and we suggest coordinating within feeder primary schools to maximise the impact of CPD.

Tartan Talent Pathway



The Tartan Talent Pathway is Scottish Volleyball's Junior National Team programme for developing the next Generation of Volleyballers, as well as Coaches. Each year Regional sessions are open to those aged 14-19. We encourage teachers and junior coaches to come along to these sessions and learn from our high performance coach. Costs

School Affiliation

Cost: £35

Allows school to compete in School Cup, Festivals, and receive Teacher CPD

Ambassador Course

Cost: £15 per person

This cost includes the course and Tier 3 membership. Upon completion, participants receive a certificate and bank of coaching resources.

Young Official Course

Cost: £10 per person

This cost includes the course and Tier 3 membership. Upon completion, participants receive a whistles, ref cards, certificate and officiating manual.

School Cup

Cost: £25 per team

This entry fee allows you to participate in the School Cup and School Plate if knocked out of the Cup.

School Festival

Cost: Free Entry

School entry is free with affiliation. Each pupil participating needs a Tier 3 membership.

Tier 3 Membership

Cost: £5 per person

Membership allows participation in School Cup and Festivals.

Teacher CPD

Cost: Free with affiliation

Organise with Foundation Development Officer. Subject to minimum numbers.

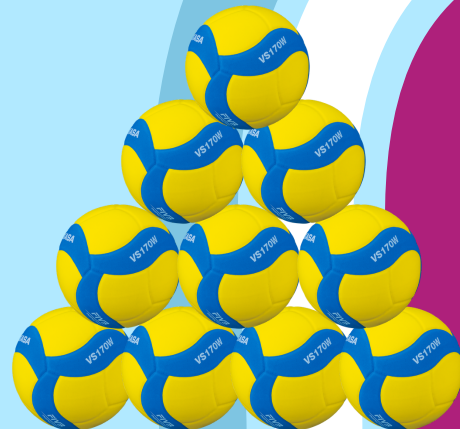
